Subj: STANDING ORDER FOR SPIRIT EVENT ATTIRE

1. I propose this order to promote school spirit within the Virginia Tech Naval ROTC Battalion.
2. During Virginia Tech athletic games and school spirited events, midshipmen are authorized to wear Virginia Tech t-shirts and jerseys. Virginia Tech shirts and jerseys are to be of appropriate taste for an up and coming Naval Officer.

A. Virginia Tech T-Shirts

- Shirts are to have no holes of any kind
- Shirts will not contain visible print that is offensive, racist, sexist, or otherwise unprofessional in nature.
- Not frayed or excessively worn
- Intentional fraying by a clothing item's manufacturer is not acceptable

B. Virginia Tech Jerseys

- Jerseys are not to be overly baggy; jerseys may not hang more than six inches below your waste.
- Not frayed or excessively worn
- Intentional fraying by a clothing item's manufacturer is not acceptable

C. Prohibited

- Wearing a Virginia Tech t-shirt or jersey to any event that is not school spirited.
 - For Example:
 - Going to the movies wearing a Virginia Tech t-shirt or jersey on the day of an athletic or school spirited event.
 - Wearing a Virginia Tech t-shirt or jersey and not attending or observing a school spirited event.
3. This privilege may be revoked by the Commanding Officer at anytime due to the failure of any midshipman to follow this policy.
